4. EXAMINATION SCHEME:

DSSSB / Delhi High Court will conduct Two Tier Examination i.e. II – Tier for the posts of **COURT ATTENDANT, COURT ATTENDANT (S), COURT ATTENDANT (L), ROOM ATTENDANT (H), SECURITY ATTENDANT**. The Examination Scheme for II – Tier is given below :-

- No request for re-checking and/or re-evaluation of papers would be entertained as the same is not provided for in the Recruitment Rules.
- DSSSB will provide a list of qualified candidates in order of merit to the Delhi High Court after conducting Preliminary Examination (Objective Type). Interview shall be conducted by Delhi High Court. Further, allocation of posts will be done by the Delhi High Court itself.
